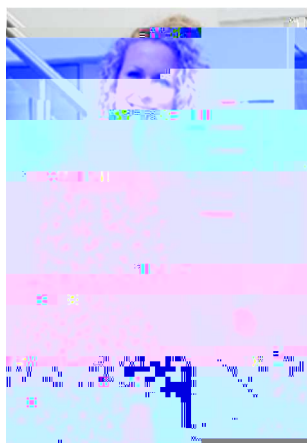


Year 13 Careers Bulletin September 2021
